PEST MANAGEMENT OVERVIEW

EFFECTIVE PEST MANAGEMENT IS A PROCESS, NOT A ONE-TIME EVENT. OUR APPROACH IS A COLLABORATIVE AND ONGOING CYCLE OF CRITICAL ACTIVITIES THAT HELP KEEP PESTS IN THEIR PLACE. THERE ARE TOO MANY VARIABLES TO PROVIDE PEST MANAGEMENT SOLUTIONS WITHOUT UNDERSTANDING THE UNDERLYING REASONS WHY PESTS INFEST A SPACE IN THE FIRST PLACE. YOU MUST ASSESS THE SITUATION.

WE DO THIS BY UTILIZING THE FOLLOWING METHODS:

COMPREHENSIVE INSPECTIONS

This will help you detect any sanitation issues or structural conditions conducive to pest infestations.

IDENTIFICATION OF ACTIVE PESTS

Evidence found in your facility will identify pest activity and problem areas.

IMPLEMENT A CUSTOMIZED SOLUTION

Based on ongoing monitoring and situation assessments Rapid Response will work with you to develop a customized program that suits your facility's unique needs.

FOCUS ON PREVENTION

We will start exclusion, sanitation, and other non-chemical options.

ENVIRONMENTALLY CONSCIOUS APPROACH

If a product is needed, your Rapid Response Specialist will select a formulation and target the applications to do the most good with the least impact on the environment

SANITATION CONSULTATION

If needed your Rapid Response Specialist will consult with you to make sure your cleaning efforts make a real impact on potential pest "hot spots."

MONITOR – DOCUMENT – COMMUNICATE

MONITOR - During regular service inspections, your Rapid Response Specialist will monitor for signs of pest activity, look for elements that might attract pests in the future and generally make sure your program is working.

DOCUMENTATION AND COMMUNICATION - After each service, your Rapid Response Specialist will provide a written service report that documents all services performed, pest activity found, action plans to correct any pest issues, and any structural and sanitation recommendations.
